The District Six Transportation Systems Management and Operations (TSM&O) Office recently completed a new staging area on Interstate 95 (I-95) and SW 8 Street in Miami-Dade County.

The site was completed to support incident management operations

on 95 Express. It is strategically located near a major entrance ramp to expedite multi-agency response and clearance times on the highway.

The site was completed to support incident management operations on 95 Express.

The staging area safely accommodates two Road Ranger pick-up trucks and one Florida Highway Patrol (FHP) unit to assist with closures on 95 Express during the evening peak period.

These vehicles stage under I-95 to

support long term closure events on the northbound mainline. The two Road Rangers are dispatched to physically block the entrance points with traffic cones, barricades and their service vehicles to prevent drivers from entering the express lanes during a major incident.

The staging area took approximately one year to complete. It was a multi-department effort between the District Six TSM&O, Construction and Design Offices. The team worked together to deliver a site that was safe, well-lit and

easy-to-access.

The site provides first responders with a safe and secure location to improve their on-the-job safety and promote free-flow traffic for the motoring public of our region.


