


## Road Ranger Retires Leland DeBooy

#### **ITS Maintenance Contractor Support**

- Ensured Fuel for Backup Generators
- Prepared 10% Spare Parts for Critical Function Devices
- Sent out Service Teams to Assess Damaged Devices
- Identified a Few Damaged ITS Devices in Monroe County
- Cleaned Video Detection Camera Lenses in Key West






## **Rear-Facing Red Lights**

- All Road Ranger Vehicles and Incident Response Vehicles (IRV) Equipped with Rear-facing Red Lights
- Statewide Safety Initiative
- FDOT Research Determined Combination of Red and White Lights Work Best
- Road Rangers and IRV Feedback
  - Motorists are Noticing the Red Lights
  - Motorists are Moving Over









## **Sequential Flares**

**COMPLETE** 

- Additional Safety Equipment for all Road Rangers and Incident Response Vehicles
- Provides Greater Visibility to Motorists within Merging Traffic









### **Wearable Lighting**

- COMPLETED
- Additional Lights to Help IRV Operators at Night
- Provides Greater Visibility to Motorists

### **System Overview**

FDC

- FDOT District Six Assumed Full Operations and Maintenance of Monroe County's Traffic Signals in 2020
- Improved and Upgraded Traffic Devices, Standardizing Outdated Infrastructure
- Promote System Reliability by Training Local Partners on ITS devices
- Managed from the SunGuide TMC with Dedicated Arterial Staff









### **Keys COAST Project**

- Completed June 2024
- First Connected Vehicle Project in District Six
- 59 Roadside Units

FDO

- 250 On-board Units
- 40 CCTV Cameras
- Traffic Signal Detection System
  - Video Vehicle Detection System
  - o Loops
- Enhances MCTSS Operation



### **Project Updates**



#### **Transit Signal Priority (TSP)**

- TSP allows communications between transit vehicles and traffic signals
- Gives priority to transit vehicles through a series of signalized intersections
- Transit vehicles must have an On-Board Unit (OBU)
- District Six is working with Key West Transit
- 10 of 16 Transit Vehicles have OBUs so far

#### **Signal Retiming & School Zone Beacons**

- Retiming of all MCTSS signals along US 1 completed
- School zone beacons and traffic signals correctly scheduled for the new school year
- Changes to the operational schedule of these devices are coordinated with MCSO
