






Roadway Clearance Time





 - o 5,344 activities






Road Ranger I-75/SR 826 Beat



- All Road Ranger Vehicles and Incident Response Vehicles (IRV) Equipped with Rear-facing Red Lights
- Statewide Safety Initiative
- FDOT Research Determined Combination of Red and White Lights Work Best







New RISC Contract


- Notice of Execution: October 16, 2024
- Mobilization Incentive Payment
 - \$1,000.00 arrival within 45 minutes in urban areas and 60 minutes in rural areas
 - \$500.00 arrival greater than 45 to 60 minutes in urban areas and greater than 60 to 90 minutes in rural areas
- Clearance Incentive Payment
 - \$5,500.00 clearing travel lanes within 30 minutes
 - \$4,500.00 clearing travel lanes in a range from 30 to 45 minutes
 - \$3,500.00 clearing travel lanes in a range from 45 to 60 minutes
 - \$2,500.00 clearing travel lanes in a range from 60 to 90 minutes






RISC Event

- Overturned Fuel Tanker with Ruptured Tanker
- Spilled Gasoline In the Roadway
- Prolonged Road Closures









Traffic Impact

- All Lanes Closed I-95 SB Before SR-932 / NW 103 Street
- Bumper-to-Bumper Congestion
- Traffic Redirected to NW 125 Street







Overturned Fuel Tanker

- Fuel tanker with Capacity of 8,000 Gallons
- Cliff Berry Provided Support to Clean Fuel
- Approximately 500 Gallons of Fuel Spilled Onto the Roadway








Rapid Incident Scene Clearance (RISC)



RISC Clearance

- Downtown Towing Arrived
- Vendor Removed the Tanker Off the Roadway
- Fuel Cleanup Conducted Before Tanker Removal









Rapid Incident Scene Clearance (RISC)



Incident Clearance / All Lanes Clear

- Lanes Opened at 11:50 PM
- Total Incident Duration 11 Hours
- Draining the Fuel Tanker and Cleaning the Roadway Prolonged the Event Duration


