New Incident Management Coordinator

Fabian Arizmendy

- **Manage the Rapid Incident Scene Clearance (RISC) Program** to ensure fast, safe clearance of major highway incidents
- **Conduct after-action reviews (AARs)** following major incidents to identify lessons learned and improvement opportunities
- **Facilitate TIM team meetings, training, and outreach** for continuous interagency improvement
- **Promote responder safety** and reduce secondary crashes through best practices and guidance



New District Maintenance of Traffic Specialist

Aldo Leon

- **Ensure safe and efficient traffic control** during maintenance, incidents, special events, and construction activities
- **Conduct MOT field inspections** (day and night) and enforce corrections or shutdowns for unsafe operations
- **Review and develop MOT plans** and concepts during project design and construction phases
- **Integrate ITS technology** into field traffic control through coordination with Design and Construction teams

FHP Dispatch Coordination

- **Staffed by District Six SunGuide TMC personnel** during peak hours:
Monday – Friday, 5:00 AM – 9:00 PM
- **Facilitates real-time communication** between FHP Dispatch and TMC operations
- **Minimizes disruption and prevents duplicate notifications** during traffic incidents
- **Verify and relay incident details** (e.g., lane closures, crash types, responder needs) to ensure accurate information sharing

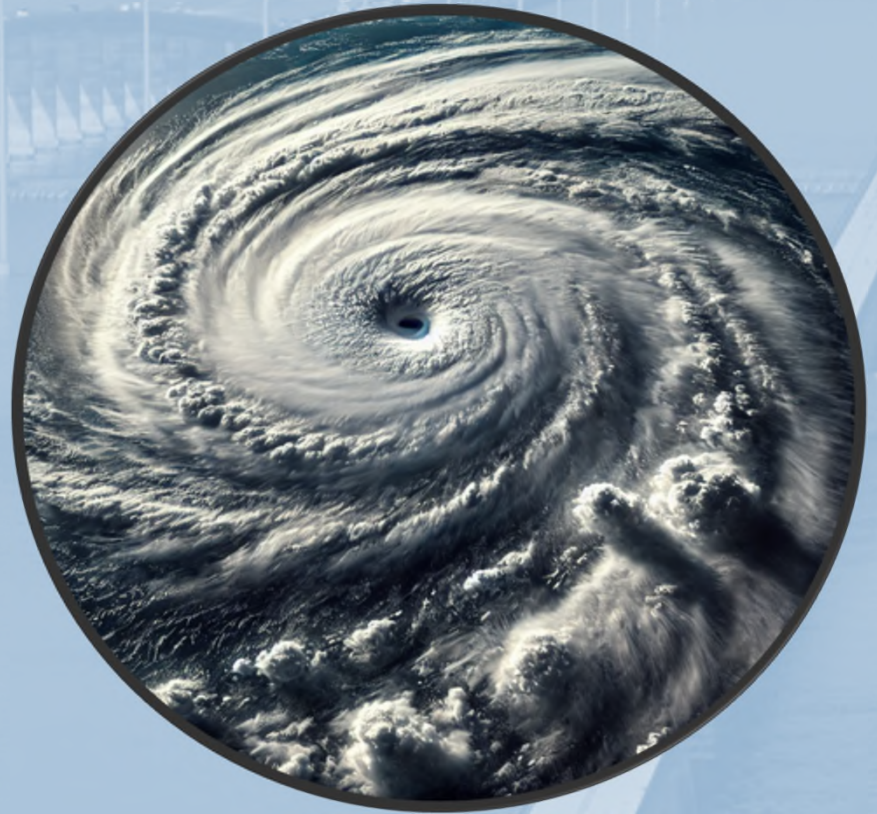

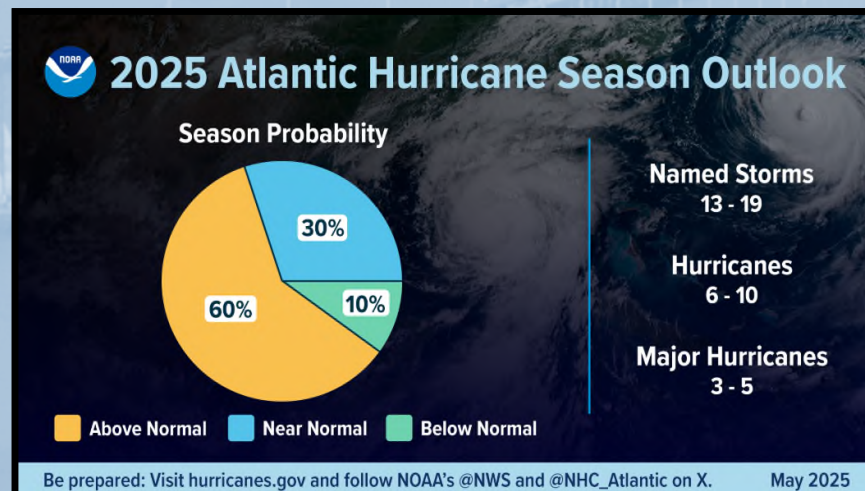

Hurricane Season 2025 Forecast

- The 2025 Hurricane Season is Estimated to Include:
 - 13 to 19 storms
 - 6 to 10 hurricanes
 - 3 to 5 major hurricanes (Cat 3+)
- Hurricane season is expected to be very active.
- Increased influence from La Niña in the Atlantic Ocean.

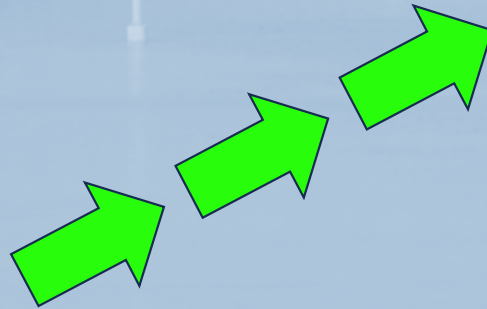
Before the Storm

- Public Information Dissemination
 - o Dynamic Messages Signs (DMS)
 - o Florida 511 (Website and Mobile App)
- Road Ranger Dispatch Support as Needed
- ITS Maintenance Contractor Coordination
 - o Fuel for Backup Generators
 - o Spare Parts Inventory



Monroe County Traffic Signal System

- Developed emergency evacuation signal timing plans
- Implemented into the Central System
- Can be activated based evacuation status



- **Helps to prioritize northbound flow** using signal timing
- Facilitate northbound evacuation

During the Storm

- Hourly Updates with District Six EOC
- Monitor ITS Devices and Monroe County Traffic Signal System (MCTSS)
- Incident Management and ITS Maintenance Resources Depart at 35+ MPH Sustained Winds
- TMC Evacuates for Category 3 and Above
- Backup Location - FTE Turkey Lake

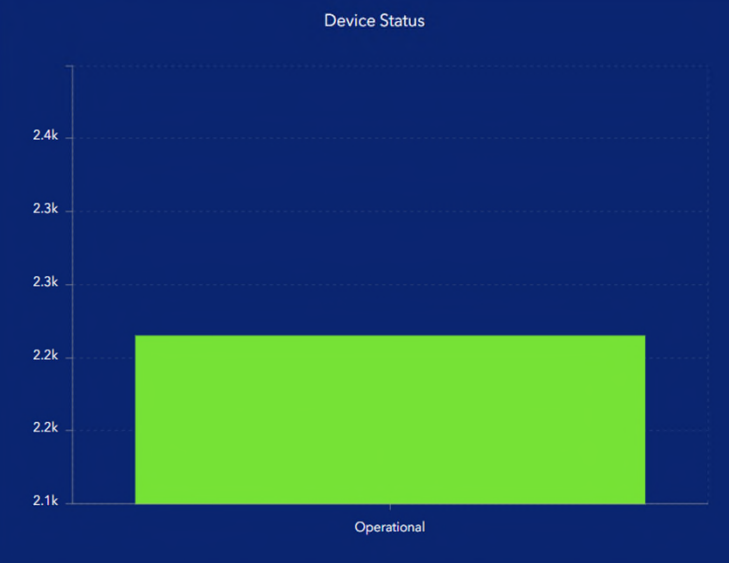
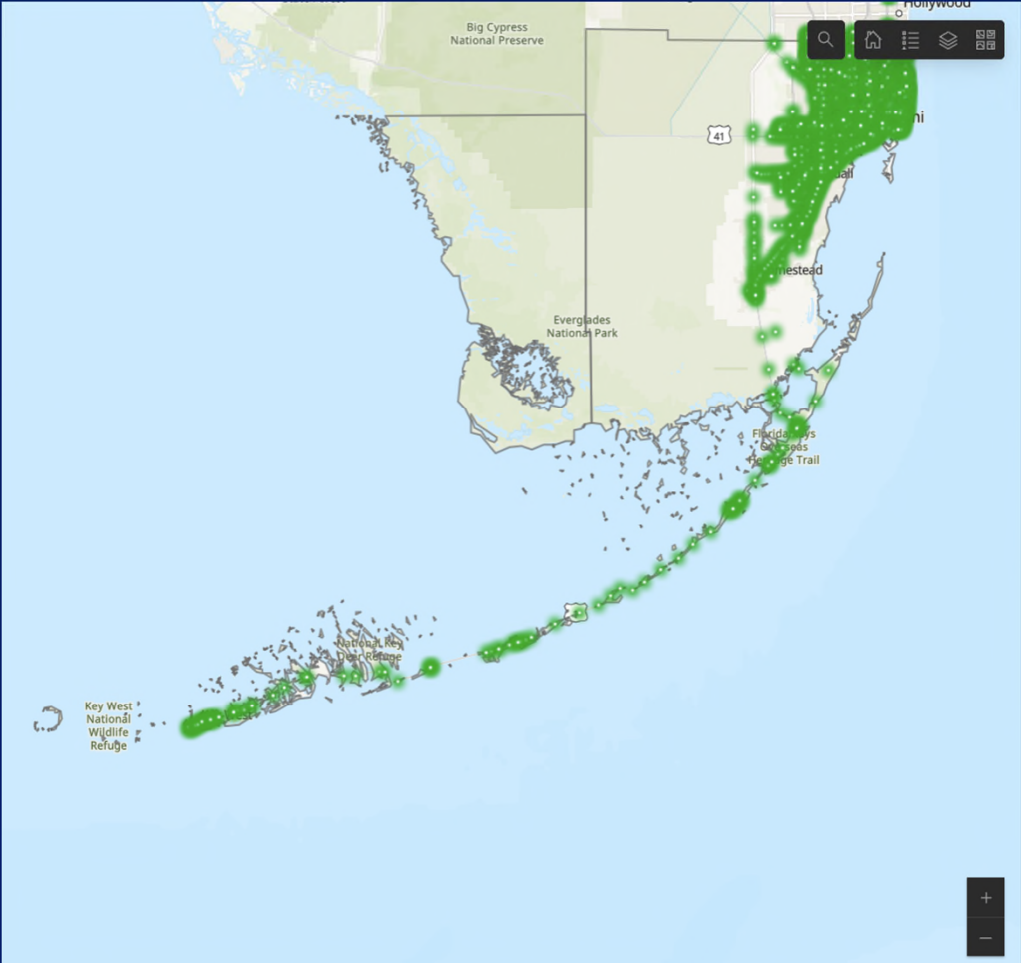

After the Storm

- Incident Management and ITS Maintenance Resources Return Below 35 MPH Sustained Winds
- Inventory and Situational Awareness of ITS and MCTSS Devices
- Reestablish Power as Needed
- Checking Communications with ITS Staff
- Road Ranger Dispatch Support as Needed
- Reporting Operational Status of Traffic Signals and ITS Devices Using eSTORM
