- Shuttle exits SR 826 West at NW 12 Avenue.
- Performs a U-turn on NW 12 Avenue.
- Proceeds eastbound on 167 Street.
- Takes the ramp to US 441.
- Arrives at the Park & Ride lot.





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

Districtwide Clearance Times








Annual Secondary Crashes


Incident Responders Site

Crash Responder Safety Week (CRSW)




November 17 through 21, 2025




Express Lanes Updates



Eligible vs. Prohibited Vehicles

- Prohibited
 - Trucks (3+ axles) unless assisting or directed by FHP
 - Vehicle Classes 6–13
 - 2-axle vehicles towing trailers
- Eligible Classes
 - Vehicle Classes 1–5








Toll-Exemption Updates

- Toll-Exempt (with registration):
 - Vanpools
 - Carpools of 3 or more
 - Public Transit Buses
 - School Buses
- Toll-Exempt (without registration):
 - Motorcycles
 - Emergency Vehicles (Law Enforcement, Fire, EMS, DOT responders on duty)
- Non-Exempt Effective July 1, 2025
 - Inherently Low Emission Vehicles (ILEV)
 - Electric Vehicles (EVs)
 - Hybrid Vehicles




Operational

- I-95 NB and SB off-ramps at NW 95 Street
- SR 826 SB off-ramp at SW 40 Street
- SR 826 SB off-ramp at SW 56 Street
- FM# 446947-1 (Phase 1): 10 Locations
- SR 826/ Palmetto Expressway Capacity Project: 3 Locations
- I-95 Ramps at Rickenbacker Causeway and SW 25 Road: 3 Locations

Under Construction

- FM# 446947-2 (Phase 2): 25 Locations
 - o NTP: September 25, 2023
 - Contract Time: 787 Days
 - o Estimated Completion: December 2025





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






Krome Avenue – Previous Coverage

- Segment 1 SR 997/Krome Avenue (19.3 Miles)
 - Okeechobee Road to Kendall Drive/SW 88 Street

Krome Avenue – Expanded Coverage (Effective on October 2024)

- Segment 2 SR 997/Krome Avenue (7.0 Miles)
 - Kendall Drive/SW 88 Street to Eureka Drive/SW 184 Street
- Segment 3 SR 997/Krome Avenue (3.1 Miles)
 - Eureka Drive/SW 184 Steet to Avocado Drive/SW 296 Street





District Six RISC Activation Event Types







RISC - Private Recovery Involvement



Scenario 1

No private company available

- RISC is activated immediately
- NTP (Notice to proceed) is issued
- RISC vendor handles the recovery

Scenario 2

Private company is available ETA longer than RISC

- RISC is activated
- IRV/FHP notify driver
- TMC informs FHP dispatch
- NTP (Notice to proceed) is issued
- RISC vendor handles recovery

Scenario 3

Private company is available but no ETA

RISC is activated

If RISC arrives First:

 RISC vendor handles recovery

If Private arrives First:

- Given chance to recover if they have the appropriate equipment needed
- RISC vendor holds until recovery status confirmed

Scenario 4

Private company confirms name, origin, ETA, and equipment

- RISC not initially activated
- RISC vendor gets heads-up
- Private attempts recovery
 If private fails, delays,
 lacks appropriate
 equipment, or FHP orders
 RISC:
- RISC is activated
