



November 17 through 21, 2025

- **Purpose:** Nationwide initiative coordinated by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and supported by Traffic Incident Management (TIM) Teams across the U.S.
- **Goal:** Honor the men and women who risk their lives responding to roadway incidents.
- **Message:** Responder safety requires action from everyone — responders, agencies, and the public.

Active Arterial Management

A traffic operations strategy used to monitor and actively manage traffic flow along major arterial roadways (like US 1 in the Florida Keys) in real time.

Ocean Bay Dr / Atlantic Ave (MM 99.5) – Sept 1

Temporary timing changes to ease NB congestion

Cause: Labor Day traffic

Timings restored after congestion cleared

College Rd (MM 4.23) – Sept 3

Adjusted signal timing due to multiple lane closures

Cause: Urgent water pipeline repair

Timings restored after MOT removal

Tarpon Basin Dr (MM 101.4) – Sept 19

Temporary timing changes for NB congestion

Cause: Vehicle crash south of intersection

Timings restored once congestion cleared



Active Arterial Management



Ongoing Construction Projects

- **Emergency Signals Improvements (250629-4 / TWO 63)**
 - 📍 *US 1 from MM 1.4 to MM 106.5* | 📅 *Started May 2025*
 - Upgrading emergency signals, cameras, and UPSs
 - Underground work complete; construction to resume mid-October 2025
 - Expected completion: mid-December 2025
 - Locations
 - East of Jose Marti Drive
 - 3rd Street
 - 89th Street
 - Layton City Hall



Upcoming Construction Projects

➤ College Road Signalization (449756-1)

- *US 1 & N College Rd (MM 5.0)*
- New signalized intersection
- Construction to begin April 2026

➤ Key West Triangle Improvements (448061-1 / TWO 004)

- *US 1 & A1A/S Roosevelt Blvd (MM 3.9)*
- Install mast arm for SB US 1 traffic
- Start date TBD

➤ RRFB Installation at Seaside Dr (448061-1 / TWO 9)

- *A1A/S Roosevelt Blvd & Seaside Dr (MM 2.26)*
- Install pedestrian Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons
- Start date TBD

➤ Flooding Mitigation at Jose Marti / Eisenhower Dr (454101-1)

- *US 1 & Eisenhower Dr (MM 1.34)*
- Replace mast arms, signal & UPS cabinets, and detection system
- Expected 2027

➤ Sadowski Causeway Signal Improvements (44806115201 / TWO 33)

- *US 1 & Sadowski Cswy (MM 53.7)*
- Modify signal operations for concurrent SB turn & opposing crosswalk
- Start date TBD

➤ Safety Improvements – Eisenhower Dr to S Roosevelt Blvd (44601125201)

- *US 1, (MM 1.34 – 3.93)*
- Add Exclusive Pedestrian Phase, Leading Pedestrian Interval, and Blank-Out Signs
- Start date TBD
